

RESOLUTION 2000- 41

**ORDER RETAINING PROPERTY ACQUIRED  
BY TAX DEED FOR COUNTY PURPOSES  
A. E. MONTANA PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, this Resolution was introduced by Susan Swimley, Chief Deputy Gallatin County Attorney, moved by Commissioner MURDOCK, and seconded by Commissioner MITCHELL. The Resolution was adopted **BY A VOTE OF 2 - 1**.

WHEREAS, in 1998 the Gallatin County Commission, in Resolution 1998-30, directed the County Treasurer to issue a tax deed for Tract A of Certificate of Survey 998 in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼, Section 23, Township 1 South, Range 3 East MPM, more commonly known as the A.E. Montana property on Campcreek Road in Gallatin County, Montana; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-8-2301(3)(d), MCA, allows Gallatin County to retain tax deed property and classify the property pursuant to Section 7-8-2501, MCA; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2000, the Gallatin County Commission, after deliberation and public input, voted to retain the A.E. Montana property and classify the same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following described property located in Gallatin County, Montana, and acquired by tax deed shall be retained by Gallatin County and classified pursuant to Section 7-8-2501, MCA:

Tract A of Certificate of Survey 998 in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼, Section 23, Township 1 South, Range 3 East MPM, more commonly known as the A.E. Montana property on Campcreek Road.
